### APPEALS COMMITTEE

Closing Date: October 5, 2022 at 4:00 p.m. local time

The Fort Nelson First Nation is seeking to fill two (2) vacancies on the FNFN Appeals Committee – one (1) Elder FNFN Member and one (1) FNFN Member.

#### Mandate and Authority:

The FNFN Appeals Committee is the appeal body responsible for reviewing and reconsidering any decision or order rendered by Council, a Committee, Board or other administrative body, except for any decision or order made according to the Minors' Trust Guidelines and Membership Code. The Appeal Committee is governed by the FNFN Appeal Committee Terms of Reference and FNFN Appeal Committee Procedures and Guidelines.

#### Appeal Committee Composition:

The Appeal Committee will be comprised at a minimum of the following *voting* members:

- One senior staff member of the Nation who may be a member of the Nation
- One non-member of the Nation who may be a staff member of the Nations
- Two elders of the Nation
- Three members of the Nation, who will be available to sit on a Panel

The Appeal Committee will be comprised of the following *non-voting* members:

- The EDA who will be responsible for annually reviewing and making recommendations to Council on the Guidelines and serve as a resource to the Appeal Committee and may only speak to appeals to provide information, as necessary
- A clerk who will be responsible for scheduling meetings and hearings, recording the minutes and handling communications
