INVITATION TO APPLY

Fort Nelson First Nation accepts applications for Temporary Call-In (TCI) Workers on an ongoing basis. TCI Workers meet our needs for backfill coverage and work load increases. Hours of work for a TCI Worker can range from 0-35 hours weekly, and this is dependent upon the employer's needs. The employer provides training for skills in entry level jobs. TCI Workers with increased skills mix and willingness to orientate in multiple service areas may work with increased frequently.

TCI Workers should have a good level of energy and be physically fit to perform the work, and should have good listening and communication skills to gather information and to ask questions in order to carry out assigned work. TCI Workers will frequently work with other employees to obtain information, supplies, tools, equipment and/or advice to solve problems.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES

Knowledge, skills and abilities will depend on the job description. Some jobs in health care and education services require proof of compliance with the provincial immunization program. Some positions are considered positions of trust and may require the successful completion of a Police Information Check, and this may also include a Vulnerable Sector check.

Job types are outlined below; employment status is casual; hours of work will vary; shifts may include weekends and evenings.

Front Office Assistant (Clerk I): \$16.65	Snow Shovelling (Worker I): \$16.65 per hour
Food Service Worker I: \$16.65	General Labourer (Labourer I): \$19.30 per hour

The stated hourly rate is the starting rate for the position for qualified applicants with required certificates, knowledge, skills, abilities and experience. The rate offered is dependent upon the type of work and the worker's qualifications. Entry level workers are awarded an entry level rate of \$14.80 per hour.
