EVACUATION ALERT

Ittsi Creek and Maxhamish Lake Area

June 10, 2023 @ 1800 hrs

An **Evacuation Alert** has been issued by the Northern Rockies Regional Municipality at the Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) due to immediate danger to life safety caused by a wildfire in the Ittsi Creek and Maxhamish Lake area, west/south west of Maxhamish Lake.

The **Evacuation Alert** area as shown in the attached map (in YELLOW) is bounded by:

- A line from 122.9964 W/59.7994 N to 123.1532 W/59.8027 N on the south
- A line from 123.1532 W/59.8027 N to 123.1564 W/59.9313 N on the west
- A line from 123.1564 W/59.9313 N to 122.9710 W/59.9308 N on the north
- A Line following 1 kilometer off Highway 77 from 122.9710 W/59.9308 N to 122.9964 W/59.7994 N on the east

An **Evacuation Alert** has been issued to prepare you to evacuate your premises or property should it be found necessary. Residents will be given as much advance notice as possible prior to evacuation; however, you may receive limited notice due to changing conditions.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- Locate all family members and designate a meeting area outside the evacuation area, should an Evacuation Order be called while separated.
- Pack essential items such as government-issued ID, medications, eyeglasses, valuable papers (e.g. insurance, credit, and mortgage information), immediate care needs for dependents and, if time and space permits, keepsakes for quick departure.
- Prepare to move disabled persons, children and/or neighbours, if assistance is needed.
- Prepare to take pets with you and move livestock to a safe area (if possible).
- Arrange transportation for all your household members. Fill the gas tanks of personal vehicles.
- Arrange accommodation for all members of the residence, if possible. In the event of an evacuation, Reception Centres will be opened if required.
- Wait for an Evacuation Order to be issued before evacuating. Monitor news sources for information on evacuation orders and location of Reception Centres.

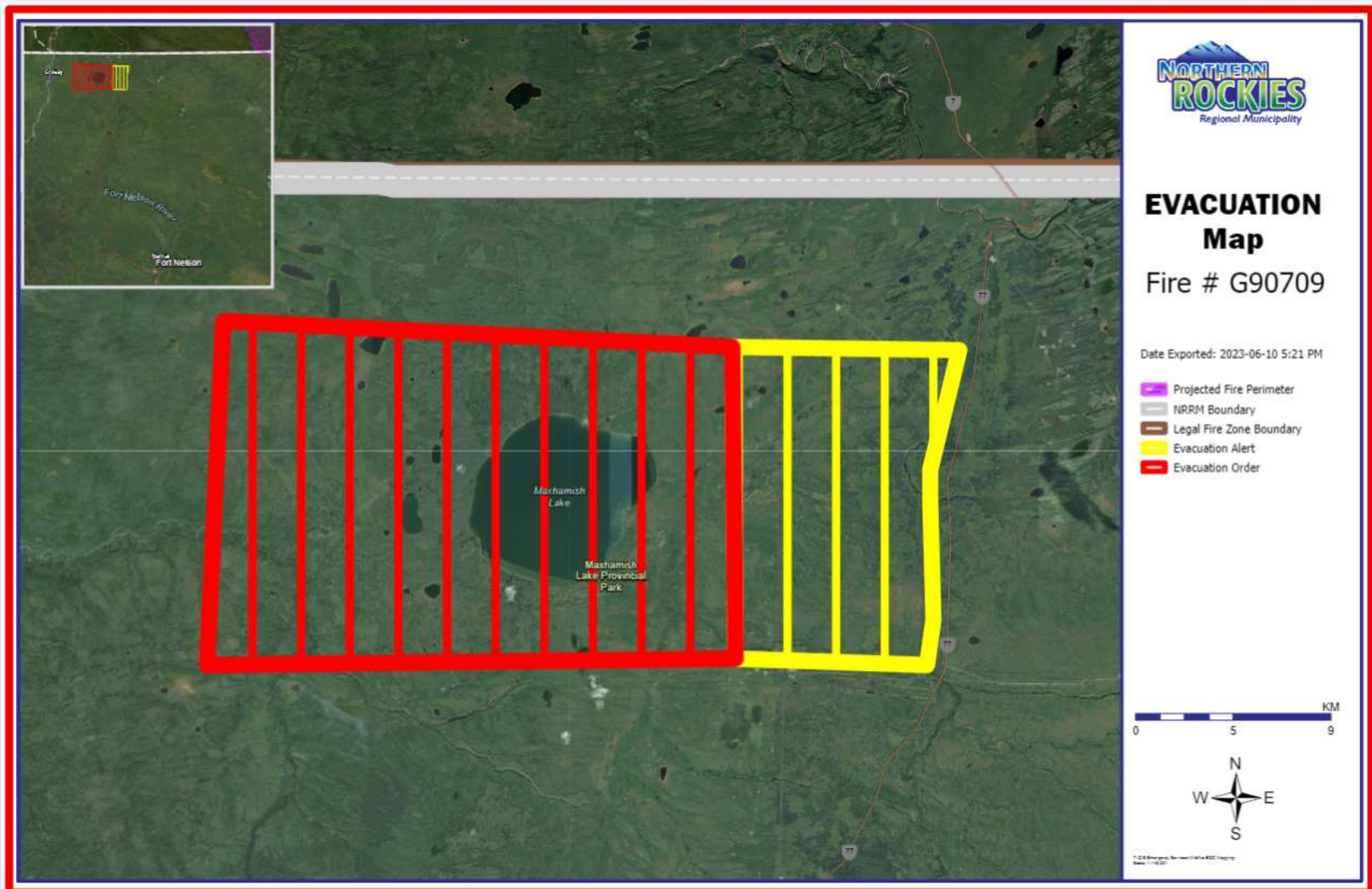

EVACUATION ORDER

Ittsi Creek and Maxhamish Lake Area

June 10, 2023 @ 1800 hrs

Pursuant to Section 12 (1) of the *Emergency Program Act* an **Evacuation ORDER** has been issued by the Northern Rockies Regional Municipality due to immediate danger to life safety caused by a wildfire in the Ittsi Creek and Maxhamish Lake area, west/south west of Maxhamish Lake.

The **Evacuation ORDER** area is shown in the attached map (in RED) and is bounded by:

- A line from 123.1532 W/59.8027 N to 123.5890 W/59.7992 N on the south
- A line from 123.5890 W/59.7992 N to 123.5782 W/59.9410 N on the west
- A line from 123.5782 W/59.9410 N to 123.1504 W/59.9313 N on the north
- A line from 123.1504 W/59.9313 N to 123.1532 W/59.8027 N on the east

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- **YOU MUST LEAVE THE AREA IMMEDIATELY**
- Call 9-1-1 if you are in immediate danger
- Close all windows and doors
- Shut off all gas and electrical appliances, other than refrigerators and freezers
- Close gates (latch) but do not lock
- Gather your family/co-workers and ensure everyone is accounted for: take a neighbour or someone who needs help
- Take critical items (medicine, purse, wallet, and keys) only if they are immediately available. Take pets in pet kennels or on leash.
- Do not use more vehicles than you have to.
- Do not use the telephone unless you need emergency service.
