## **NOTICE – PRE -VISITOR REGISTRATION for HEALTH-CHECK POINTS REQUIRED**

Due to the extended BC Provincial Health Order, which is now extended to February 05, 2021, we are requesting that only those persons living outside the FNFN Traditional Territory, who are also the **immediate family members** of Fort Nelson First Nation **registered residents** apply for visitor entry.

At this time, we will only be approving immediate family members of registered residents for entry into the community from outside our Traditional Territory.

As per the Provincial Health Order there is a Non-Essential travel ban in place, please only plan a trip here if absolutely necessary ie. caregiver, family support. Please to reduce the risk of infection we need to all abide by the health measures in place.

This decision has been made in consultation with our Chief and Council, in consideration of the health of our community and for our vulnerable population, as we have minimal health care capacity if an outbreak occurs in our community.

All persons travelling from outside our FNFN Traditional Territory are required to let Fort Nelson First Nation know of their arrival by completing and submitting a Health Check-Point Visitor Registration form which can be found by following this link [http://www.fortnelsonfirstnation.org/uploads/1/4/6/8/14681966/health-check-point-visitor-registration-form\\_updated-fillable.pdf](http://www.fortnelsonfirstnation.org/uploads/1/4/6/8/14681966/health-check-point-visitor-registration-form_updated-fillable.pdf)

The Health Check-Point Visitor Registration form will be required for immediate family members travelling from outside our Traditional Territory to our Community, and must be sent to [rhonda.mathison@fnnation.ca](mailto:rhonda.mathison@fnnation.ca) and [checkpoint@fnnation.ca](mailto:checkpoint@fnnation.ca) .

**For drop off:** If you are dropping off a form on behalf of a family member who has sent it to you, please have the forms submitted to the Health Centre, or to the Administration building (to Cougan or Heather) during work hours (8:30am to 4:30 pm, Monday to Friday) to avoid delays

**Anyone without a pre-filled and registered form** will not be given access to the community

**Vehicles with a pass** and with passengers or drivers displaying key symptoms related to COVID-19 will not be given access to the community, with out a isolation plan in place.
