OVERVIEW OF THE NORTHERN REGIONAL TABLE (NRT).

This Governance table is the high-level advisory team that provides direction and advice to the FNHA Northern Regional Executive Director. This is also the group that meet directly with Northern Health Senior Executive Team to set joint directions on health improvement for Northern First Nations citizens.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

The NRT works on behalf of all Northern BC First Nations and takes its collective direction from Northern First Nations. At a regional level, the NRT representatives from each sub-region also take direction from their respective Sub-Regional Caucuses, bringing feedback to the NRT and undertaking regional-specific health and wellness efforts. Individually, each NRT member has responsibilities to advance the regional and provincial-level work of the NRT.

COMMUNITY REPS (THREE)

One person is elected by from each of the three sub regions by the Chiefs (and equivalent) in each of the sub regions, for a three-year term.

COMPENSATION

The Northern Region provides reimbursement for travel based on the schedule authorized by the FNHA Board of Directors and accepted by the FNHA, FNHC, and the FNHDA Board. This includes meals, accommodation and distance travel. NRT Members are compensated per the Terms of Reference for meetings (both in person and virtually) lasting longer than two hours.

TIME COMMITMENT

Time Commitment The Northern Regional Table meets formally at least four times per year, the day prior to the meeting with the Northern Health Executive. There is pre-reading assigned In advance of these meetings to keep participants well informed. In addition to this, we provide training and planning meetings in Prince George at least once per year. From time to time we rely on the NRT members to provide input and advise on political, technical and community issues to guide us in our decision making process.
