Fort Nelson First Nation On Reserve Land Use Plan

Closing time: Proposals must be received before 4:00 PM (PDT) on June 12th 2020.

The Fort Nelson First Nation (FNFN) is issuing a RFP to qualified consultants to assist the FNFN in developing an On-Reserve Land Use Plan over a period of approximately 15 months (with possible extension) the project will conclude with a final FNFN Land Use Plan for membership approval and handbook/orientation package for FNFN's Lands and Community Infrastructure & Safety Services departments. The final product will include a Community Engagement summary that tracks and summarizes methods and outcomes.

The Land Use Plan will be developed AS PER FIRST NATIONS LAND MANAGEMENT RESOURCE CENTRE INC. and Fort Nelson First Nation **LAND USE PLANNING FUNDING ARRANGEMENT** with guidance and support from an existing technical team made up of FNFN staff and external consultants. In addition to the final product, the consulting team will be required to conduct a scan and produce a summary of existing in-house land use planning documents, including state of knowledge reports, traditional use data, and maps to prepare for community engagement and the development of the FNFN Land Use Plan.

FNFN's Community Infrastructure & Safety Services department invites proposals from consultants with experience working with Indigenous communities and demonstrated success leading communities through robust engagement processes and producing useful community strategic visioning and planning documents for community use, to develop a Land Use Plan for FNFN's reserve lands in accordance with this Request for Proposals (RFP).
